

Four pieces of anti-fraud legislation: a new law governing fraud crime hazard prevention, amendments to the Code of Criminal Procedure, amendments to the Communication Security and Surveillance Act, and amendments to the Money Laundering Control Act, will strengthen ROC's legal system and enhance law enforcement tools for fighting fraud.

Premier Cho Jung-tai said a comprehensive crackdown on fraud, organized crime, corruption, drugs and illicit money flows is part of the Executive Yuan's initiative to promote public safety, which forms one of the government's two central policy pillars alongside promoting economic development. In addition to ensuring that this year's anti-fraud measures are reliably implemented, the central government currently plans to allocate substantially increased funding to combat fraud crime in its 2025 general budget, demonstrating its concrete support and commitment toward the new legislation and updated measures.
